### 1. Security Analysis (4<sup>th</sup> Edition) by Benjamin Graham

I have a very rare silver colored hard back copy of this edition. I have seen only three copies of this book in my collecting career and believe that it must have been a special edition printing. The book is in excellent overall condition. Minor wear to the corners of the book is evident and the first 22 pages contain some light underlining in pencil. Previous owner wrote his name in bottom of front cover. \$350

This is an original 1937 first edition with the rare green hard cover. The title page is marked C-C. The book is in really nice shape with only minor wear to the corners and the top and bottom of the spine. No underlining or markings are present. SOLD

This is an original 1937 first edition with the blue hard cover. The title page is marked F-X. This is an ex-library copy and as such signs of use are evident. There is wearing on the corners and edges. The top of the front spine is torn and page 57 of the book has been folded over as if someone had folded it to use as a book mark. Nice reading copy. \$100
